

2010-2011 TRAVEL TEAM TRYOUT SCHEDULE

All tryouts are held at our Merchant Road soccer complex at 6:00PM. **All players must register for the fall season prior to the third tryout in order to be placed on a 2010-2011 travel roster.**

There are two Skills Evaluation nights. Boys and girls trying out for U10 and U12 teams may attend either skills night, but only their designated age/gender group scrimmage nights.

U10/U12: must attend one skills night and the two age/gender appropriate scrimmage nights. If you need to miss one scrimmage night you must contact the program Director.

U14: must attend at least two age/gender appropriate scrimmage nights. It is highly recommended you attend all three scrimmage nights. You must contact the program Director if will miss any of the three scrimmages. There is no skills night for U14.

Please Notify the Boys or Girls Program Director if injury or illness requires you to miss a tryout.

Any player not selected for a travel roster may participate in our intramural program or receive a refund as desired.

The Framingham United Soccer Club was incorporated in 1975 and is dedicated to the development and promotion of soccer in Framingham. To achieve that goal, the club provides training and competitive play for Framingham residents. The club offers intramural (in town) play and travel play as part of BAYS, Boston Area Youth Soccer League, which includes over 50 surrounding cities and towns. Intramural play does not require a tryout. Travel players are selected by the club committee as follows:

Travel team players are selected after a six week evaluation period that includes:

Three evenings of tryouts - Players are encouraged to attend all three tryouts to receive the best possible evaluation. Players not attending all three tryouts must notify the Program Director PRIOR to the tryout. Players must attend a minimum of two tryouts.

Players trying out for U10 or U12 teams must attend one skills night as one their three tryouts.

Current coach provides players evaluations including, skill, commitment and dependability.

Evaluation of players at current spring games by selection committee members.

Travel teams require an extra level of commitment from players and some additional costs that typically include:

Two practices per week.

Five home and five away games per fall and spring season.

Participation in at least three soccer tournaments (usually Labor Day weekend, Columbus Day weekend and Memorial Day weekend).

Registration is expected by the last tryout for the fall season and by Nov 1 for the spring. Find information and links to online registration on our web site, FUSC.org or by calling 508-875-FUSC.

Fall and spring season commitment. (Teams stay together from September-June). Please note that players may need to register in the fall and again in spring due to registration system limitations.

Participation (encouraged) in a winter indoor soccer program. (Most teams play at least eight weeks of indoor soccer at a local indoor soccer facility).

2010/2011 age requirements (based on date of birth):

U10-Born 8/1/00 to 7/31/02 (typically entering 3rd or 4th grade)

U12- Born 8/1/98 to 7/31/00 (typically entering 5th or 6th grade)

U14-Born 8/1/96 to 7/31/98 (typically entering 7th or 8th grade)

Travel team opportunities are limited. Not all players trying out may be selected.

U10 and U12 players not selected are encouraged to participate in the intramural program. Note: U12 Girls has not had enough participation the past two years to form a viable separate intramural program. We expect that will be the case this year as well, and encourage all U12 girls to attend travel tryouts, as there may be no U12 girls intramural program. All U14 teams travel. We will do our best to place all U14 players as space allows.
